How To Order Your Coffered Ceiling

The Coffered Ceiling is extremely versatile and comes in two versions. Shown here to the right is the recommended version, with interlocking "ribs" that form a grid. A different version (shown on page one), incorporates 12" x 12" x 4" boxes which can be used for lights or speakers. Either version can accommodate hidden wire run channels if required.


To order, ASC will need photos of your ceiling and a scale drawing, showing location of all lights, vents, etc. There is also a small design fee, which will be applied to your final purchase price. Then our drafting department will design a grid designed to fit around any obstacles, and a parts list, all included on a measured drawing for easy installation.

Installing Your Coffered Ceiling

The Coffered Ceiling is easy to install, and doesn't require any cutting or



carpentry. An installation guide is included with every order, and any person with reasonable DIY skills can easily tackle the job. Using a laser guide is highly recommended, or just snapping chalk lines works fine too. Rib sections are adhered to flat ceilings using acoustic cement; sloped ceilings require additional screws or nails.



Coffered Ceiling With Junction Boxes

The Coffered Ceiling with junction boxes has more steps, yet is also easy to install. ASC includes templates to help make the job go smoothly. The pattern grows from one corner of the room until the entire ceiling is complete. The



same three templates are used throughout to maintain uniform spacing. For flat ceilings, acoustic ceiling adhesive is used. Sloped ceilings will require additional

screws or nails to prevent drift.
